目標：相對於精神分析訓練裡的三個過程，被分析、被督導與理論研究，本課程並無法提供這些內容，因此盼參與者了解此種型式所具有的侷限。本講座試圖以精神分析的觀點(去年以佛洛伊德的論點為主軸，2005年三月起以英國學派的論點為主軸)，省思人格違常的現象及其對於診療室裡治療雙方的影響，觀察自己在診療室裡的種種舉動，增加自己對於臨床現象的解釋觀點。如果因此而對精神分析更有興趣，並願更深入接觸精神分析，則是本講座的附帶目標。

Historic City (Kaoshiung, Taiwan)

The earliest known human settlement in Kaohsiung City dates from about 4700 to 5200 years ago. The dominant people during that period of time were Taiwan's Pingpu aborigines (various plains-dwelling aboriginal tribes that have almost completely assimilated into the Han Chinese community). Many archeological sites have been discovered, including Mt. Longevity, Chiucheng (relics of the old fort built in Qing dynasty in Tsoying), and Houchin sites.

Diverse Metropolis

In the scenic cityscape of Kaohsiung, there coexists the modernity and tradition, and the humanities and nature. There are both modern buildings—numerous attractive department stores and the 85-story T&C Tower—and historical sites in downtown Kaohsiung. While the number of five-star hotels in Kaohsiung has been on the rise, the boisterous and aromatic Liuho night market still pleases the palates of gourmets and visitors in love with Taiwanese traditional delicacies.

Ocean Capital

Approximately 70% of the Earth's surface is covered by oceans. Oceans have long supported the development and prosperity of many cities, which all have one thing in common, the vitality. Kaohsiung Harbor bears witness to the city's vitality derived from the oceans.

Future Municipality

21st century is an oceanic century. Thus for the development of metropolitan Kaohsiung in the new century, the city government will focus on transforming Kaohsiung into an international bay city with emphases on the balance of living, ecosystem, and production. Many major projects under way are all geared toward this goal, such as the Kaohsiung Mass Rapid Transit system, the Kaohsiung Multi-Functional Commerce & Trade Park, and the Asian Pacific Regional Operation Center (APROC).
